REGIS is responsible for technical elements

compatible assurance via ICPPE / PEGIS / accreditation assessment

REGIS should not set the standards, that's e.g. IEC61588.

this is continuous communication with PEGIS

ensure all infrastructure are coherent, not fragmented information

To ICPE request: - aligning policies, experiences

- participation by REGIS to ICPE/ICPE

- sustainability of REGIS

- give specific use cases for a baseline. (80/20 rule).

reviewed process for ROBB proof way as well.

that is more resilient and stable than splitting a passphrase.

- OCSP is not a fully functional replacement for CRL.
(pre-creating future CRLs could be, but needs very tight xm control of
it under conditions similar to the root CA key.).

- SIAN support added by introducing RA route.
